Fifteen years ago, Bruce LaGrow presented Father Champlin with the idea for a golf tournament to benefit the Guardian Angel Society. Who doesn't like to golf and give back at the same time? What started as a great idea for a fun and fruitful fundraiser has blossomed into an annual event that brings together an incredible community of golfers around our great cause! Held at Radisson Greens, our special 15th anniversary tournament included 84 golfers and raised over \$19,000 toward tuition assistance, mentorship, and tutoring for at-risk kids, the most we've ever raised in a single tournament!

Everyone was in high spirits and it was truly a special year. One skilled golfer even made a hole-in-one; the first ever in the 15 years of this tournament!

Since its inception, this golf tournament has raised over \$200,000! All of which has gone toward making a difference in the lives of children in our community. Save the date for August 6th, 2020!

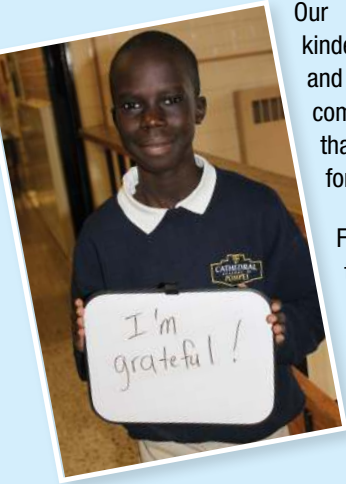
KATHY FEDRIZZI SCHOLARSHIP

2019 has been a year of celebration and growth for Father Champlin's Guardian Angel Society. In July, we announced that Kathy Fedrizzi, long-time Executive Director would be transitioning to part-time Executive Director Emerita. We established a special 2019-2020 Kathy Fedrizzi Scholarship in her honor that has, to date, raised over \$10,000 for our highest need families! Every year tuition rises and we continue to receive more requests for aid than we have funding, so everyone's generous donations to this special scholarship fund will make a big difference in the lives of many families.

Sarah Ioele has been appointed by the Board of Directors to lead the Society going forward as the Director of Community Relations & Development. Kaitlyn Cogswell has been promoted to Operations & Marketing Manager and manages many of the Society's day-to-day activities.
