

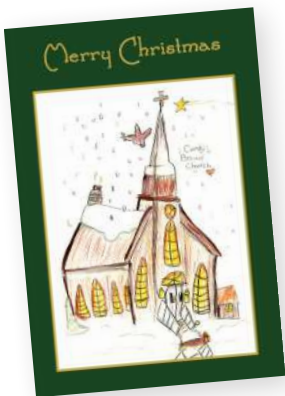

OUR MOST SUCCESSFUL TO DATE 17TH ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

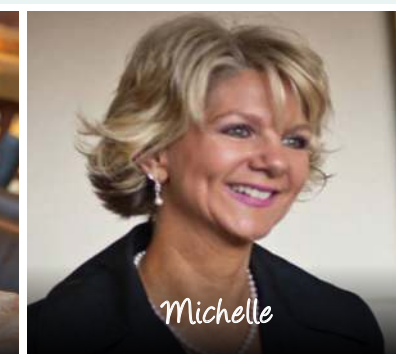

Thank you to Angela, LouAnn, and Michele for your commitment and dedication. We are blessed to have you as part of our leadership team!



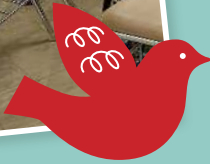
