The Society is happy to announce we were awarded a grant from the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation beginning in January 2022. In the summer of 2021, the Guardian Angel team submitted a project proposal to the Foundation in hopes of obtaining a grant to underwrite our part-time Program and Development Coordinator position to research our alumni scholars for the last 25 years. By the grace of God, we were awarded the entirety of the project's cost, and we could not be more excited to take on this endeavor!

As the first American saint, Mother Cabrini is a powerful example of Catholic values and principles. Mother Cabrini knew the importance of providing for the most vulnerable as an immigrant herself. The Foundation, established in 2018, is working to build on her legacy of service. Grants are provided each year to organizations in New York working to improve the most underserved populations' overall health, well-being, and quality of life.

The Society has not been able to track most students after graduation, an intention we have always had, but could not complete.
