



THE GUARDIAN ANGEL SCHOLARS

The Guardian Angel Society scholars who rely on tuition support represent a very diverse population. In particular, our Sudanese students are faced with more academic difficulties than others. Some of these students will not succeed in junior high school without literacy and math intervention. This involvement with our mentors and tutors will enable our students to graduate from high school on time. Studies show with the help of mentors and tutors, these at-risk students are more likely to graduate and have a 14% higher employment rate.



THE MENTOR & TUTOR DIFFERENCE



Guardian Angel Society's Mentor & Tutor Program was implemented to ensure each scholar successfully graduates from high school and is prepared to be a productive citizen in our community. Participating scholars boast increased grades in many

academic areas and clearly enjoy the enrichment they receive from the relationships built between them and their volunteer mentors. We are proud of the graduation rate of our Catholic School students. An average of 30 students were mentored and tutored this year at CAP, Bishop Grimes, Bishop Ludden and CBA. In addition, an experienced math tutor provided weekly math support for junior high students.



PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

SUMMER 2017 PROGRAM ACADEMICS AND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

- Held at St. Vincent de Paul Church with enrollment of 20 students, grades 7-9. Average daily attendance: 94%
- Literacy and Math instruction led by a team of four experienced tutors, two assistants and four volunteer mentors.
- A week of Science camp in collaboration with SUNY ESF. Grant gave our students the opportunity to enjoy field trips and science projects which were displayed on the last day of the program.
- Youth development activities provided organization and study skills.
- Program speakers engaged students.

SUMMER 2017 PROGRAM AT CAP

In addition to the summer program for junior/senior high school students, 30 students at CAP participated in its own summer program in July. This program was designed to help improve reading, comprehension, and science content, with an emphasis on the development of vocabulary and writing skills.

NEW TO SUMMER 2018 PROGRAM

The Guardian Angel Summer Program is a bridge for students leaving CAP and entering junior/senior high school. We focus on math, literacy and communication. Business Leaders, Professionals and Coaches from the community will speak about what it takes to achieve goals and make a difference.

HOW CAN I HELP?

- \$800 toward two experienced Math or Literacy Tutors for the Summer Program
- \$500 supports a Math or Literacy Tutor during the school year
- \$300 helps provide bus transportation for a summer enrichment field trip
- \$100 supports the end-of-year celebration for students and mentors
- \$50 provides new mentor training materials

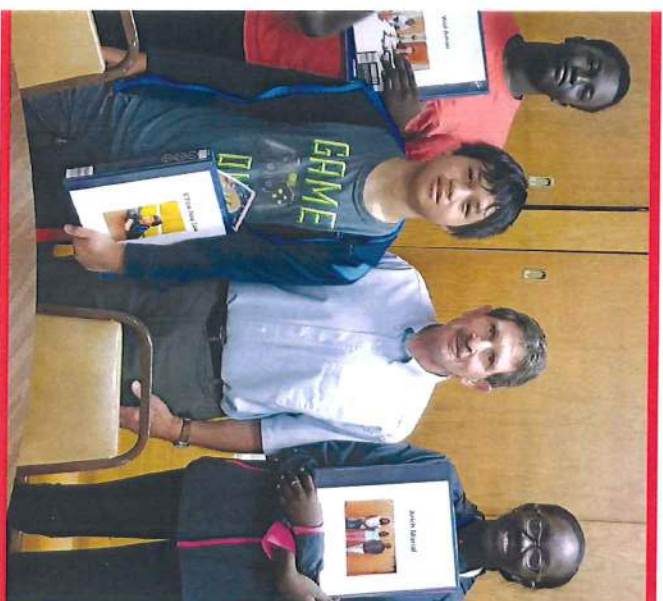
