I am very pleased to enclose a packet of our 16th Annual "Kids with Wings" Christmas cards. This is our special way of saying "thank you" for the support you have given Father Champlin's Guardian Angel Society. It is because of you that hundreds of children in our community have been given a chance for success and make a quality education a priority. This year's card has been created with the artwork of 4th graders Rosalie Dewh and Katrina Huynh, and with Katrina's special message of "Rejoice and Be Happy".

The student population at the elementary school that the Society supports, Cathedral Academy at Pompei, has 121 students this school year. Of that 121, the Society is supporting 78 of those students or 65%. The demographic breakdown is as follows: Sudanese 38%, African American 24%, Asian 19%, Caucasian 13%, Hispanic 6%. As you can see, a very diverse group of children make up the population of this model urban elementary Catholic school. The Society will follow these children to Catholic high school graduation by supporting them financially and with mentor/tutor support.

On behalf of the Guardian Angel Society, its Board of Directors and Trustees, I want to wish you a very Merry Christmas filled with time to "rejoice and be happy" as you come together this holiday season.

Featured student... Alek Aman

Alek Aman was born in South Sudan. The horrific war there led her family to Egypt in the hopes of escaping the suffering. In 2004, when she was seven years old, her father brought the family to the United States to find a better life.

Alek spent one year in public school but the transition was very difficult as her language skills were poor which made it feel impossible to learn anything.

Desperate to reduce the frustration of his children and *Program Coordinator* to ensure they receive a quality education, Alek's father searched for a better educational option. He learned of Cathedral Academy at Pompei (CAP) and Sister Joana Baidoo from St. Vincent dePaul Church Refugee Ministry. The tuition was more than the family could afford but the Aman family was assured that help was available. "The Guardian Angel Society was very generous with tuition assistance during my time at CAP." says Alek. "CAP was a very good environment for learning. My teachers were very helpful, and my English improved. The teachers made learning interesting, and so today, my best subjects are math, science and English."

Another important thing Alek learned at CAP was how to pray. Alek continues, "Father Champlin visited often, and spent time in our classes. The Guardian Angel Society also provided mentors."

Alek chose to continue her education with Guardian Angel Society assistance at Bishop Ludden Junior/Senior High School where she is now a sophomore.

This little girl who was barely able to speak English well enough to follow along, worked with her teachers and supporters like the Guardian Angel Society. By the time she was in 8th grade, she was receiving high academic honors. She received high honors again in 9th grade but this time, her award included the highest honors for math.

Her goal after high school is to attend college and then medical school to study endocrinology to find a cure for Type 1 diabetes.

At this time, the Guardian Angel Society is also helping four of her siblings to receive a quality education at CAP and Bishop Ludden.

Alek says, "We are grateful for this help so that we can learn and prepare ourselves to do good things for others. Thank you Guardian Angel Society for all you have done to help my family receive a quality, Christian education."
